



### CORPUS CHRISTI CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL – PE PREMIUM SPENDING (2021/22)

The Primary School Sports Funding is provided by the government to improve the quality and provision of PE in schools. The overall aim is to provide more healthy and active lifestyles for children of primary age in the hope that they will develop a lifelong love of healthy exercise.
