

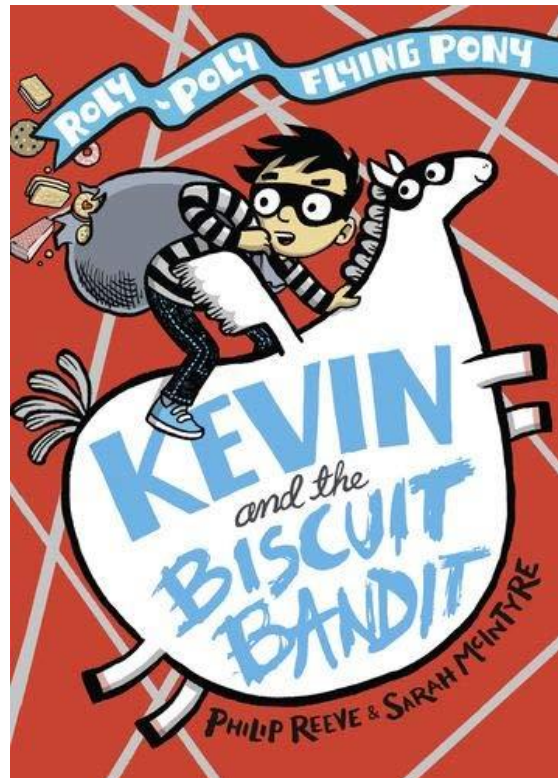
## Kevin and the Biscuit Bandit by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre

You'll have to read the book to see why she is so naughty!

I've read other books by this writing duo and I love the way they use vivid, cartoon style illustrations throughout their books. They bridge the gap between comic and novel really well and help to add interest to the story. The book was enjoyable and the story quite amusing but it won't be making my favourites shelf, I much prefer *Oliver & the Seawigs*, which was their debut novel.
